Make some animals to add to the scene.</p> 	<p>Test 10 different objects in your home to see if they are magnetic. You will need a magnet for this investigation. Write down if it was magnetic or not. Remember to predict if you think it will be magnetic or not.</p>	<p>Ask your friends and family which is their favourite African animal (elephant, zebra, giraffe, lion, leopard, rhinoceros) and create a pictogram or a bar chart.</p>
<p>Look at and explore making animal patterns using different media e.g. charcoal zebra prints, painted giraffe print</p> 	<p>Write a poem about magnets.</p>	<p>Write your own poem about a country in Africa or an animal that is native to Africa.</p>
<p>Make a collage of an African savannah</p>	<p>Find out 5 facts about magnets.</p>	<p>Find out the populations of South Africa, Egypt and Morocco.</p>
<p>Find out and list 5 different African dishes</p>	<p>List 5 games or sports that use forces (pushing and pulling).</p>	<p>Draw a poster about a famous African landmark e.g. the pyramids in Egypt, the great sphinx in Egypt, an African savannah or the River Nile in Egypt.</p>
