Compare life for a rich Anglo-Saxon with a poor one, including housing and clothing.	Make a list of 10 animals that are carnivores, 10 that are herbivores and 10 that are omnivores.	Make a model of an Anglo-Saxon boat, weapon or house, using clay or plasticine.
Use the internet to research information about the Anglo-Saxons	Keep a food diary of what you eat for a week.	Copy a picture (from a book or the internet) of an Anglo-Saxon object or a scene of village life.
