Write a message using Viking (remember to write a translation of it)	Make a poster about how bees pollinate flowers.	Design and make your own Viking jewellery or shield.
Compare life for a rich Viking with a poor one, including housing and clothing.	Make a list of 10 British plants, trees or flowers.	Make a model of a Viking longboat, weapon or house, using clay or plasticine.
Use the internet to research information about the Vikings	Draw and label a flowering plant.	Copy a picture (from a book or the internet) of a Viking object or a scene of village life.
