Make a model of a helmet suitable for coal mining.	Research Mary Anning. Find out who she is and why she is important.	Write your own diary entry as if you were a coal miner. Think about what their whole day would have been like from getting up to going to bed.
Design a board game about coal mining.	Make a collage out of rocks.	Interview an ex-coal miner. You could video this and send this on ClassDojo. If you can't interview a coal miner you could write 5 questions you would like to ask them.
Design a coal mining outfit.	Design a poster showing examples of the three rock types (igneous, sedimentary and metamorphic)	Write an explanation about why coal mining was so important in Mexborough and the local area.
Draw or paint a picture of a coal mine.	Find a rock and paint it to turn it into a piece of art.	Find out where some coal mines were in South Yorkshire.
