Write a brochure for the National Coal Mining Museum	Write a fact-file about different types of rocks	Make a model of a miner's lamp or helmet
Write a diary entry as if you were a child working in the coal mines in Victorian times	Write a biography about Mary Anning	Draw a picture to show the different layers of rock and soil
Interview an ex-coal miner. You could video this and send this on ClassDojo. If you can't interview a coal miner you could write 5 questions you would like to ask them.	Design a poster showing examples of the three rock types (igneous, sedimentary and metamorphic)	Write a menu for what a miner would have had in their 'snap tin' for lunch/dinner
Go on a walk in the local area to find evidence of the coal mining industry (street names, head gear etc)	Make a collage out of small, different coloured rocks.	Find a rock and paint it to turn it into a piece of art. Leave it for others to find.
