Make a sundial. Set it up outside and evaluate how well it works. Record shadows throughout the day.	Make a shadow puppet to explore shadows and how the size of a shadow changes and why.	Write a brochure for the National Coal Mining Museum.
Design a reflective outfit to keep cyclists safe on the roads.	Design a game which uses mirrors (e.g. a mirror maze)	Write an explanation about why there was a coal mining strike in 1985 and what happened after that.
Make a model of a lighthouse.	Write a poem about light and shadows. It could be an acrostic poem e.g. L I G H T	Write a menu for what a miner would have had in their 'snap tin' for lunch/dinner.
Make a poster about sun safety.	Find 5 ways to keep safe in the sun.	Go on a walk in the local area to find evidence of the coal mining industry (street names, headgear etc)
