- Communication about children's emotions, injuries, feelings needs/should be better
- Better communication from teachers and other staff
- More awareness of dates for diary can we have dates for the whole year in advance?
- Let parents know about strikes in advance although I know it is difficult as it is not always possible to change your schedule last minute
- I would recommend to have first aiders
- Don't allow parents to comment on dojo posts better to contact school or a private message. Staff need
 protection as well
- Retrain some staff on additional needs of pupils as they are stressed, overworked, understaffed and have little patience
- More staff to help in school
- · Add a one-mile daily run
- More after school clubs
- The car park

- Could the school have a cycle stand so the older kids can bring their bikes to school?
- I would recommend this school to anyone
- No blanket punishments for the class if one child misbehaves
- I think school needs to educate staff further on additional needs funding for children is lacking, budget cuts have not helped the children or staff
- Amazing school, will be sending my younger children
- We feel the school is being treated more as a business and children are an afterthought. Children's needs and quality of care isn't being met due to funding
- As parents we like that the school works everyday to make focused children. It is very nice and please continue after school clubs
- More help for children and staff working with budget cuts and minimal staff is no good for anyone or fair for the school
- School could focus more on staff well-being
