As historians, the children will find out about:

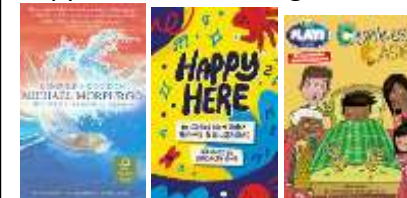
- The Ancient Greek period through historians evidence
