As Y5/6 mathematicians, our children will access the White Rose scheme and study:

- Number and place value including Roman numerals to 1000
- Addition and subtraction
- Multiplication and division

Art

As artists, the children will:

- Research printing techniques
- Create a printing block.
- Use relief and impressed techniques on an overlay
- To evaluate artwork

Writing

As authors, the children will write:

- A mystery story
- A newspaper report
- A poem

Geography

As geographers, the children will find out about:

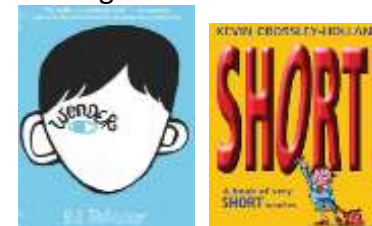
- The countries of South America
